Introduction: Capitol Special Committee for National Emergencies and Crisis

Our committee wishes to empathize with all the districts and each of them can be in a well-stable dialogue that can finalize in a diplomatic resolution.

Dealing with the problematic that all the members already consider we would be grateful for your honorable participation in this unique committee.

It has primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security. It has 13 Members, and each Member has one vote. Under the Charter of the United Nations, all Member Districts are obligated to comply with Capitol decisions, Since 1990, the Capitol has dramatically increased its activity and it now meets in nearly continuous sessions. It dispatches military operations, imposes sanctions, mandates arms inspections, deploys election monitors and more.

The Capitol is comprised of 13 districts, divided into two categories: the privilege and the unfortunate. District 1's industry is manufacturing luxury items for the Capitol, considered the wealthiest district, the only other wealthier place being the Capitol itself; district 2 is presented solely as the home of the nation's stone quarries and masonry workers, but it is also where many Peacekeepers are recruited, trained, and where weapons are manufactured for their use; district 3 Its main industry is technology, and the people manufacture televisions, computers, and other electronics; district 4 Its major industry is fishing, and children are apparently trained for jobs in this industry at a young age; district 5's industry is power; district 6 its principal industry is transportation, district 7's industry is lumber and many of its residents have experience with hatchets, axes, saws, and other tree cutting tools; district 8's industry is the production of textiles, and they have at least one factory that is primarily used for making Peacekeeper uniforms; district 9's industry is grain. Little is known about this district, just that there are lots of farmland for grain; district 10 Its main industry is livestock, and it provides meat to the Capitol; district 11's industry is agriculture - orchards and fields of grain and cotton surround the district. Almost everything grown is shipped directly to the Capitol. It is one of the poorest districts in Panem, second only to District 12; District 12's main industry is coal mining, but after the Second Rebellion, the mines were closed and their main

industry became the production of medicines; district 13 was one of the thirteen districts of Panem. Its main industry was nuclear weaponry. It was supposedly obliterated during the Dark Days as a warning to the other twelve districts of the Capitol's might.

One of the characteristics of this committee is the veto power that has been present in the Capitol since its creation, this privilege acknowledges the outstanding districts which are districts 1, 2, and 3.

Those districts have the right to get together at any time during the sessions, they have the responsibility to take the most important decisions and to be all in favor or against in the voting process.

How does it work? If there are internal conflicts in any of the districts the Capitol recognizes the power of punishment in a pacific way, the established solution that it was decided was that each district will give to the Capitol their goods until the districts built a solution.

Development of the topic: The creation of a new government system as soon as possible in order to avoid a national war

We believe that before a new world it is time to have a new decision-making structure.

The district was established to harvest raw materials, such as lumber, fur, and fish, necessary for Capitol's growing empire, The districts believed governments existed to serve and protect the rights and interests of its people, not to serve and protects its interests. So when the Capitol government began passing laws that seemed to serve its interests rather than that of its people, it was met with much disapproval in the colonies; the districts boycotted, protested and even rioted over the new laws. The Capitol government responded to the rebellion by sending troops to the districts to restore order and enforce the new laws but the increased military presence only escalated the conflict, in response to the battles, the districts formed the Rebels to help them to fight against the Capitol,

The disappearance of the Capitol have unleashed a movement if the districts to restructure the government; districts 4, 5 and 6 start to manipulate so one of the main districts achieve an important role within the new government system.

The revolution of the thirteen districts caused changes and internal conflicts, the public opinion of the thirteen districts became aware of their identity and unity against the government, the period after the war was characterized by economic depression and political crisis, the thirteen districts at that time were ruled by the Capitol.

Current situation

Katniss is the new image of the rebellion, she is the Mockingjay. For now, she is in the 13th district, which she considered destroyed, she is next to the people of the 12th district as well because she has been bombed by the Capitol; Katniss decides to be the image of the rebellion in exchange for President Coin recovering Peeta and the other hostages alive. To do this, Katniss visits the different districts to capture the support of the people, they are desperate and looking for a new way out thanks to the rebellion. The frightened capitol continually attacks the different districts, Katniss, Gale, and others decide to go to the Capitol, where they will fight and look for President Snow to kill him; they cross some dangerous places, also some of the rebels are killed, when Katniss manages to reach the President's mansion, she sees how some parachutes of a hovercraft fall, they are children who bring food and medicine to the people. Parachutes are bombs, which explode by killing many of the children, including Prim, Katniss's little sister after President Snow is interrogated, he ends up admitting that he did not send those bombs, but that most of the attacks were caused by District 13 on the orders of President Coin.

District 12 was bombed by district 13 and it was ordered by the President Coin, the one that is in charge of district 13, when Katniss prepares to execute Snow, she realizes that president Coin was the one who has to die, nailing the arrow that was aimed at Snow.

At this point Paylor, a rebel leader is the new president of Panem, district 12 together with others who are trying to rebuild their places.

The Hunger Games are over, and the arenas have been destroyed, now that the Capitol is destroyed the districts are looking for a government that allows each district sovereign and could govern its way, any other district would have any power to tax or regulate trade and there were no branches in the government to enforce the laws.
